**JULY 27-29 EARTHWORKS EXPO 2007 PRESENTS IN-DEPTH WORKSHOPS
ON SUSTAINABILITY, GREEN LIVING**

DENVER, CO – Sustainability event EarthWorks Expo has announced a comprehensive schedule of over 80 workshop presentations throughout the July 27-29 event at the Denver Merchandise Mart.

“We’ve planned a wide range of workshops to provide EarthWorks Expo attendees the opportunity to design their own experience through participation in sustainable living topics and hands-on learning activities that most appeal to their individual areas of sustainability interest,” said event organizer, Michael Lindemann.

The workshops are sixty and ninety minutes in length and include topics of Green Building, Renewable Energy, Water Conservation, Sustainable Living, Global Change, Agriculture, Home Décor & Interior Design, Residential & Commercial Energy Efficiency, Home Heating & Cooling, Green Investing & Real Estate and Youth Workshops. A highlight of the workshops is Hands-on Straw Bale Building, a three-part workshop presented by Curtis Scheib, president of Colorado-based Ecobuilders. This workshop will address all construction phases of building a straw bale home and includes a hands-on straw bale wall-building activity that will give participants a real-world taste of the straw bale construction process.

Workshops by EarthWorks Expo’s world-class lineup of sustainability thought leaders include Crisis as Opportunity: Living Better on a Hotter Planet, presented by Dr. Elisabet Sahtouris; Getting a Grip: Clarity, Creativity and Courage in a World Gone Mad – A Conversation with Frances Moore Lappé; and Peak Oil is an Opportunity! led by Richard Heinberg and Michael Brownlee.

All EarthWorks Expo workshops are free of charge to ticket-holders and will take place in the six workshop rooms in Expo Hall I. Exceptions are the straw bale workshop, which takes place in the south parking lot near the main doors; and the youth workshops, which take place in the Kids Garden in Expo Hall III.
